- 4. Entries should arrive at Ferris Church of Christ (3443 N. Crystal Rd., Vestaburg, MI) between 11-11:15 a.m. on October 25. Judging to begin at 11:30, people's choice judging from 11:45-12:30.
- 5. Winners to be announced at 12:30.
- 6. All chili types welcome---white, vegetarian, wild game, non-traditional, etc. All will be judged as one category and winners selected from the entire pool of entries.
- 7. Heat level must be identified at time of entry.
- 8. Only one entry per individual.
